

24 leave your gift at the altar and go. First make things right with your brother or sister and then come back and offer your gift.


# Five Principle Steps of Matt. 18

- 1. Overlook Minor Offenses
- 2. Talk in Private
- 3. Take One or Two Others Along
- 4.Tell It to the <u>Church</u> (Church Accountability)
- 5. Treat as a Nonbeliever

# Crucial Elements When Seeking Help

- Keep the circle of people involved in a conflict as small as possible for as long as possible.
- Make every effort not to give them unnecessary details about the conflict.
- Only when you and the other person are both <u>present</u> should you give a detailed explanation of your perceptions.





Acts 6:1–7 CEB
