The Shocking Truth About the Spirit Sermon Series

The promises of the **Spirit** (Jn. 14:16-17)

- 1. The Spirit will be sent. (Jn. 14:16-17)
- 2. The Spirit will be with us. (Jn. 14:17)
- 3. The Spirit will be <u>in</u> us. (Jn. 14:17)

During the Old Testament era, the Spirit's work was more individual and rarely corporate.

God promises the Spirit to all <u>humankind</u>. (Joel 2:28)

If the Spirit is so awesome to have in us, why didn't God give the Spirit to all of God's people sooner?

Jesus was not yet glorified. (John 7:39)

What is the <u>purpose</u> of the Holy Spirit?

Purpose of the Spirit is to <u>convert</u> the heart to Jesus.

<u>Repentance</u> is prompted by a demonstration of God's love for us lovingly displayed on the <u>cross</u>. (Rom. 2:4)

The supreme, humble, gracious work of the Spirit it to show us who <u>Jesus</u> really is.

The Holy Spirit was given to the early church.

The **Spirit** is available, yet Jesus hasn't returned. Something is **missing**.

The <u>baptism</u> of the Spirit is of great need. (Matt. 3:11; Mk. 1:8; Luk. 3:16; John 1:32-34; Acts 1:5; 11:16)

The early church received the baptism of the Spirit. What were they doing that fostered the baptism?

They were in one <u>accord</u>. Constantly in <u>prayer</u>. Came together <u>regularly</u>. Shared <u>everything</u>. Helped one <u>another</u>. (Acts 1:14; 2:42-47; 4:32; 5:12)

We are missing the <u>Unity/Togetherness</u> factor.

Jesus gave one more <u>commandment</u> to help with the <u>togetherness</u> factor. (John 13:34-35)

<u>Love</u> each other.

Promise = we will receive the <u>baptism</u> of the Spirit

Our great need = <u>Togetherness / unity</u> factor and the <u>baptism</u> of the Holy Spirt for our <u>entire</u> church.

Action Steps

- Surrender to <u>Jesus</u>.
- Let the Spirit <u>convict</u> the heart.
- Spend more time with Jesus in <u>prayer</u> and <u>study</u>.
- Get involved.
- Come together more.
- Reach out and <u>help</u> someone.
- <u>Love</u> like Jesus.
- Live well and love well.
