## **Observations from Churches That Are Thriving and Growing Young**

Empathy is <u>Contagious</u>

To empathize with young people we have to explore Three Ultimate Questions:

Who am I?

Where do I fit in?

What difference do I make?

Young people's journey to identity, belonging, and purpose ends <u>later</u>.

Young people's journey to identity, belonging, and purpose starts earlier.

Today's culture creates pervasive <u>stress</u>.

Over <u>eighty</u> percent of young people connected to a church agree that their involvement <u>decreases</u> their stress.

Churches that are growing young <u>empathize</u> with young people and become a place that decreases stress.

American teenagers are not <u>hostile</u> toward religion because they don't care about it much.

Churches that are growing young <u>empathize</u> with young people and become a place that offers a <u>compelling</u> faith community.

Churches growing young appreciate and <u>empathize</u> with how technology is a double-edged sword for young people eager to belong.

Churches that grow young <u>recognize</u> the absence of caring adults and healthy families in a young person's life and become a place that provides the needed support.

#### **Ideas For Action**

Pray

Respond with <u>Grace</u>, <u>Love</u>, and <u>Mission</u>.

Replay your own journey.

Ask why.

Stereotype no more.

Deepen <u>relationships</u>.
